ALLOWANCE OF RESIDENTS TO
PROTEST PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT IN WRITING

In order to ease the burden on taxpayers, the City Assessor and the Board of Review, and to ensure that all taxpayers have an equal opportunity to be heard by the Board, the City of Hazel Park hereby resolves, according to provisions of MCL 211. 30 (7) of the General Property Tax Act, that the Board of Review shall receive letters of protest regarding assessments from resident taxpayers from the first Tuesday in March until it adjourns from the public hearing for which it meets to hear such protests.

All notices of assessment change and all advertisements of Board of Review meetings are to include a statement that resident taxpayers may protest by letter to the Board.


