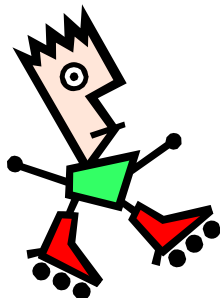
CITY OF HAZEL PARK PARENT'S CODE OF ETHICS:

LEARN TO SKATE: BEGINNERS (ALL AGES) \$30/6 WEEKS

Saturdays, 10 a.m. - 12 noon
Sept 25 - Oct 30, 2010

Classes are 6 week series with one makeup on the 7th week. This is a group instruction only. Two hours of roller skating in a public Beginner Session with a 20 minute group instruction in starting, stopping, forward skating, practice exercises, equipment knowledge and fun. This is a more low key session which encourages the skater to practice and gain balance at their own pace.

CHILD BEGINNER AND ADVANCED AGES 14 & UNDER \$36/6 WEEKS

Saturdays, 12 noon - 1 p.m.
Sept 25 - Oct 30, 2010

Classes are 6 week series with one makeup on the 7th week. Beginners: A group class in starting, stopping, forward skating, safety rules, beginning backward skating, practice exercise, games and musical fun. Advanced: A group instruction in more advanced skating for children. Instructors will place the children in this group after observing them. Introduction to figure skating, jumping, spinning, and more advanced forward and backward movements. They will learn terminology as well as having fun doing musical games. The children will progress with the U.S. Roller Skating Star Program.

BLADING/ROLLER SKATING (CHILDREN 5+ AND ADULTS) \$36/6 WEEKS

Tuesdays, 5:30 p.m. - 6:30 p.m.
Sept 21 - Oct 26, 2010

Classes are 6 weeks series with one makeup on the 7th week. A group class in beginner skills in the art of in-line roller skating. You may use your own in-line skates if they are clean and rink safe. The instructor will check skates before class. In-line skates are available at \$2.50 per class. Suggestion: please wear comfortable clothing and we recommend wearing kneepads, wrist guards and a helmet. As the class progresses the instructor will advance the technology to suit the students.

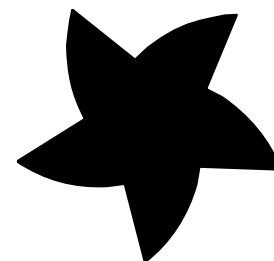

TUMBLE TOTS: 18 MONTHS - 3YRS

Thursdays, 5:30 - 6 p.m. FEE: \$30

Parental involvement is required. Children will tumble, stretch and have some fun with music!

KARTWHEEL KIDS: AGES 4-5YRS

Thursdays, 6 - 7 p.m. FEE: \$45

This course offers the preschool age child an introduction to basic gymnastic skills on preschool equipment.

BEGINNER I: AGES 6 AND UP

Thursdays, 7 - 8:30 FEE: \$50

This class introduces basic gymnastic skills to the school age child on bars, beam, floor and vault. Students will learn rolls, cartwheels, round-offs and handstands, all with correct form.

BEGINNERS II: AGES 6 & UP

Thursdays, 7 - 8:30 p.m. FEE: \$50

This is a continuation of Beginners I. Students will work on more challenging skills while stressing form. Students must know cartwheels, running round-offs and bridge with one foot.

Karate Classes

Classes are offered to boys and girls age 5 - 12 years. Each class is \$5 per lesson, with \$20 registration fee. This is an on going program. your child will have the opportunity to test for his/her next belt color at the end. Classes are held on Tuesdays and Thursdays at the Community Center

from 6-7 p.m. for beginners and from 7-8 for the color belts. **THE FIRST CLASS IS FREE** with a spectacular demonstration held on Tuesday September 14. All instructors are certified.
