COMMUNICATIONS FROM DEPARTMENT HEADS

DPW Director DuBerg spoke to the proposed bicycle lane on Woodward Heights. The road will not accept a dedicated bicycle lane, although a shared lane is recommended.

Police Chief Buchholz advised that it is dangerous to leave one's car unlocked when heating it in the morning, as it greatly increases the chance of auto-theft incidents.

COMMUNICATIONS FROM CITY MANAGER

City Manager Klobucher announced that new projects are forthcoming, though details cannot be released until they are finalized. He also thanked the Sutar-Sutarek-Meyer Foundation for their recent \$100,000 grant to the Hazel Park Promise Zone. The Foundation also gave \$25,000 to the Police Reserve Auxiliary Program.


Mayor Pro Tem Aubry congratulated the City Councilmembers. She was also glad to see so many people in attendance and looks forward to serving them.
