2. Michigan Municipal League (MML) Alternate Selection

Councilmember Sullivan inquired as to how the OAKSTEM Program will work in conjunction with the City's current tree-replacement plan. Planning Director Campbell advised that OAKSTEM will serve as a backup for existing tree-replacement zones, as well as other areas severely lacking in foliage. Mayor Webb added that the selected tree species will not negatively impact sidewalks.

City Manager Klobucher advised that increased BS&A software functionality is forthcoming.
